Camp Program

The Lady Berry Basketball Camp is designed to teach the fundamentals of basketball needed to play the sport properly.

With the use of stations, each camper will receive individual instruction on the basic fundamentals necessary. In addition, each camper will have the opportunity to compete in organized game settings.

It is our goal that each player will leave camp having been exposed to the proper skills and techniques. With this information, we believe that the player's desire and willingness to work on these skills will directly affect her progress as a basketball player.

Areas of Instruction

Defense (Man-to-man principles, positioning, terminology)

Shooting (Proper form, Footwork, Shot selection)

Ball-handling (Proper form, stationary, motion, change-of-direction moves)

Game Situations (5 on 5, 3 on 3, 1 on 1)

Competition Drills (Individual, Partner, Team)

Passing (Proper form, bounce/chest passes)

The camp will take place at Logansport High School – Auxiliary Gym (Upstairs in the Berry Bowl). Campers should arrive to camp 15 minutes early and be prepared to begin their session promptly. Camp ends at 8:00pm each night and parents should make arrangements to have their daughters picked up no later than 6:30pm (Grades 3-5) or 8:00pm (Grades 6-8).

Campers must provide their own shoes (no flip-flops or sandals), socks, shorts, and t-shirt. Campers should arrive dressed to play (i.e. no watches or other jewelry). Campers may also bring their own water or sports drink to camp, as long as it is in a closed container. Water fountains are available at the Berry Bowl during breaks.
